A TALE THAT BEGAN IN THE LAND

lutruwita, as it was known by the Indigenous Tasmanians who occupied this land tens of thousands of years before European settlement, has long been a place of beauty and bounty. These early inhabitants lived off the harvest from land and sea, and today's Tasmanian community is no different.

The majestic scenery of Tasmania's coasts and mountain ranges alike have shaken and stirred many a visitor. Our *Forbidden Fruit* is a dark Martini, highlighting flavours from Cape Grim, to the Derwent Valley.

Using the purist water in the Southern Hemisphere, 666 Vodka provides a spirit with Soul, and Crème de Casis lights the palate aflame. A juxtaposition of light and dark.

Tasmania's scape has changed since English colonization, one such introduction, is the Sloe Berry. Growing on hedges, for an autumn harvest, Sloe Berries have flourished in the Tasmanian climate. And just like the settlers of olde, Tasmanian Sloe Berries are still harvested and steeped in gin to create Sloe Gin, as highlighted in our *Wallflower*.

Tasmania, "The Apple Isle", promises locals and visitors alike the perfect environment for a vast array of fruits. Due to its iconic apples, it is no surprise that the Huon Valley is the place for some of Tasmania's best cider houses and brandy-makers. The well-travelled fellow will perhaps know the mountain range as *The Sleeping Beauty.*

A TALE OF SETTLEMENT

The land became the grounds for the stories of its people. From convict to curious explorer, those who came made of it something new:

Painless Pugh tells the story of Doctor William Ross Pugh, the ship doctor aboard the Derwent. Arriving in Hobart, he set off to Launceston to fulfill two desires; to court the love of his life, and to join a medical Practice. Doctor Pugh went on to marry the love of his life and set up his private practice: St John's Hospital, in 1844. Doctor Pugh was also the first surgeon to use ether on patients, in Australasia.

On the other hand, New Orleans had a heavy influence from the French, where Brandy became a go-to and must-use ingredient for some cocktails such as the Vieux Carré. Tasmania, at the time less impacted by the recent Depression and Prohibition, found itself fruitful in local apple brandies as showcased in our *Taffy's Tipple*.

Patsy's Fruit and Nuts evokes the resilience of both the land and its early convict community. An Irish 'Cockney', Patsy Maher worked the public works gang, in Hobart, until he earned his ticket- of-leave in 1856. He established himself as a fruiterer and sold fruit and nuts to the elite at the Theatre Royal.
